‘ēkeu: brim

‘elelau: end of leaf

hakahaka: full of holes as in loose weaving

hāunu hūnā: added moe woven in and folded to make a kū in such a way that it isn't obvious, hidden add

hāunu pelu: kū inserted and folded to make a moe then woven in a more conspicuous way, folded add

hāunu: to add strands, increase

hemo: remove, open

hi'i: to finish edge

‘ilikai: horizontal

ipu: hat block, crown of hat

ke'o ke'o: white

kīhae: to remove thorns

koana: width of strip and size

koe: stripper, to strip

kōkala'ole: thornless

kōkala: thorns on leaf

kū pololei: vertical

kū: stand, upright

kua: midrib

kūka'a: roll of lauhala

kūkū: thorns

kupe: twist

lauhala: leaf of the hala

maka 'o'eno: twill, double weave

maka li'i: small weave

maka moena: single mat weave, checker board

maka: mesh in plaiting, row

mau'u: strand

moe: lie down, horizontal

pā: top of crown (shape of plate)

pahu: hat block

pākī: softened

pāpale: hat

pelu: fold, turn over

piko: center of crown of hat

po'ala: to roll each leaf

po'o lau: base of leaf

pū hala: whole tree

puni: finish, complete

ulana: plaiting or weaving

'ula'ula: brown
